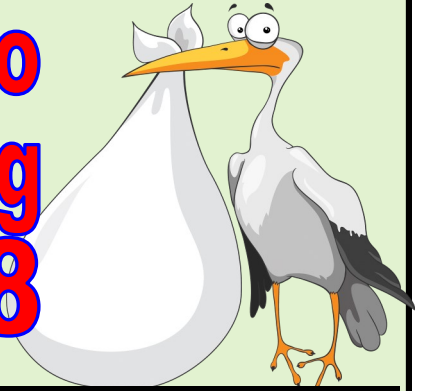
About our Speaker Brad Dacus, Esq.

PJI has a network with hundreds of volunteer affiliate attorneys and handles more cases on the West Coast than any other organization of its kind.

Brad Dacus can be heard weekly on The Dacus Report on more than 170 radio stations across the country and also as a guest speaker on numerous radio and television programs across the nation. He has appeared on America Live, CBS Evening News, CNN, Dateline NBC, Good Morning America, MSNBC, NBC News, News Talk TV, and The Today Show and numerous times on FOX News.

Mr. Dacus' varied public speaking opportunities include public debate and testifying before the United States House of Representatives in Washington, D.C. He has also testified numerous times before the California State Legislature on legislation affecting religious freedom and parents' rights. Mr. Dacus continues to speak regularly at churches, conferences, graduations and conventions throughout the United States and was presented an honorary Doctorate of Religious Freedom and Family Rights degree from California Baptist University in recognition of his commitment to faith and justice and his work protecting parental rights and religious freedom through the Pacific Justice Institute.

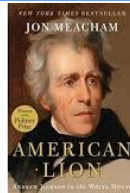

We Build The Wall, Inc.

Betty Robnison, OCFRW April, 2019, Newsletter



I heard about the GoFundMe page to raise money for the Wall last December. At the time I wasn't sure if it was legitimate but thought if lots of people donate, it will show politicians we mean business. Within a short period of time, over \$20 million was raised!

The founder of this project, Brian Kolfage, is a triple amputee Iraqi Veteran. His accomplishments are amazing. He was injured in 2004 while serving in the Air Force, performing in combat security operations. Just 11 months later, he walked out of Walter Reed Hospital!

Since then he's worked as a civilian for the Air Force, overseeing security for foreign travel, earned a Bachelor's Degree in Architecture Design, and co-founded a coffee company that became Amazon's top selling grocery product in less than a year.

He learned that it was not feasible to give our government the money he had raised for the Wall, so he started a non-profit (he takes no salary) and recruited many experts to determine how best to get the job done.

To move the money from GoFundMe, each donor was offered the option of a refund or to transfer the donation to the new organization; 94% of us have transferred the money.

We Build the Wall works with private landowners to build the Wall, to meet or exceed various regulations and requirements, for a cost that is less than a quarter of government estimates. The goal is to build as many sections as can be funded. Brain says BIG donors are waiting to see results. The first ground breaking was supposed to take place in May—it's been moved up to April!

The Advisory Board is composed of such notable people as Kris Kobach, Tom Tancredo, Steve Bannon, Sheriff David Clarke, Curt Schilling, Angel Mom Mary Ann Mendoza, Eric Prince, and others.

Two Town Halls were held the week of March 10th, both can be seen on the website (WeBuildTheWall.us) or on You Tube. The panelists were many of the people mentioned above and a Breitbart Texas editor, Brandon Darby, who has spent ten years writing articles about the border.

A few highlights from various panelists at the Town Halls:

**An Israeli company that built a Wall on the Egyptian border, which has proven to be 99.9% effective, is a consultant.

**It will be a "smart" Wall, having features like sensors to detect in ground vibrations (which would identify tunneling attempts) and other sensors to detect and photograph people.

** The aim of the Wall is to funnel illegal border crossers to 'choke points' where the undermanned Border Patrol will have better control.

***\$100 billion, annually, is the Federal and State cost in public benefits for illegal aliens, and that accounts for the taxes they might pay.

**Massive illegal and legal, if they don't want to assimilate, immigration is the lynchpin in Liberal Progressives' plan to destroy this country.

*Remittances to Mexico rose to \$33.7 BILLION in 2018! Republicans have suggested, since the late 1990s, to tax remittances sent to Mexico. Companies like Western Union do not favor this as they make millions of dollars on remittances every year.

**Cartels are now making more money from transporting asylum seekers than from drugs.

**Angel Mom Mary Ann Mendoza says 4,000 people—and that's a conservative number—are killed, every year, by illegal aliens.

**Specific cartels should be designated as 'foreign terrorist organizations' for us to lawfully stop their money laundering and freeze their assets. Cartels must be destroyed; Mexican people are certainly suffering, too.

**Congress must act quickly to change asylum regulations; we can't survive massive immigration while being a welfare nation.

More Funds for Illegal Aliens in Governor Newsom's Budget

The budget contains 17 "Budget Summary Chapters". Searching each for "undocumented", the term used to designate illegal alien, yields seven entries in two Chapters: "Health & Human Services" and "Higher Education". A total of \$569 million is allocated for the undocumented, mostly for MediCal and some for legal ser-vices and "Know Your Rights" sessions for illegal aliens, administered by the UC system.

\$25 million, from the General Fund, is earmarked by the Governor for an "Immigration Rapid Response Pro-gram" to help non-profits & others assisting those seeking asylum. Remember, around 80% of asylum seekers are NOT eligible for it and there's a case backlog of almost 800,000, which will take about four years to hear.

ACTION ALERT!

Please call or email your state Senator and Assembly member (their contact information is listed on the last page) to oppose these tax payer funds going to illegal aliens, especially since we have so many critical issues that need to be addressed. Tell the Republican officials that we expect them to **speak out** about this!

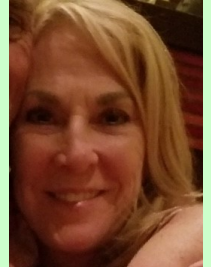
